### From the President

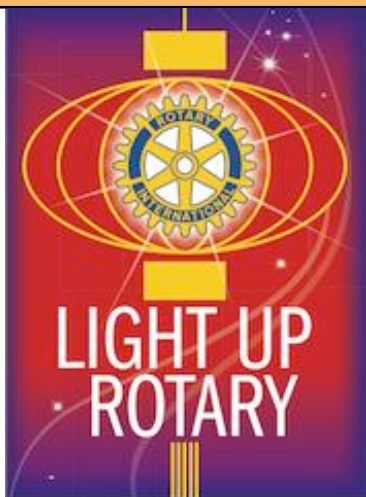
